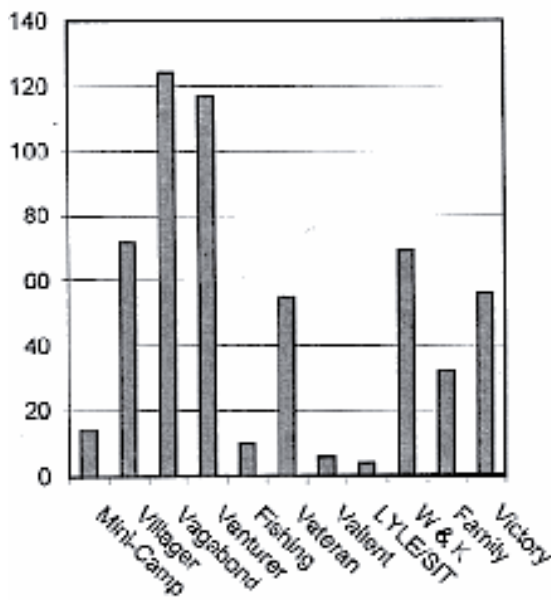

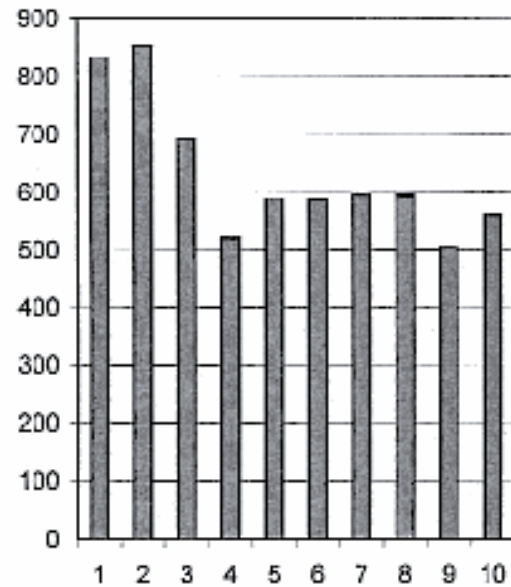

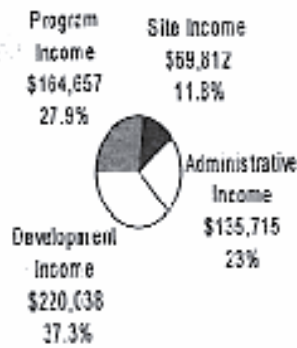
Summer 2010

by Program



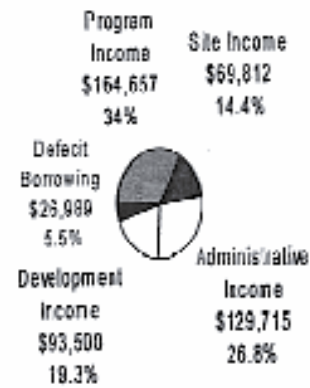
SUMMER CAMP

2001 - 2010



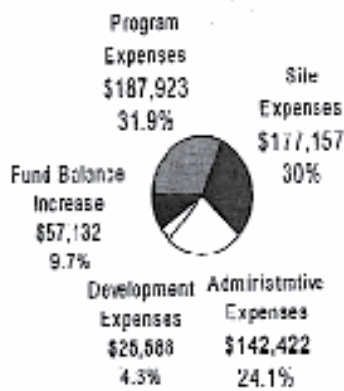
2010 Total Income



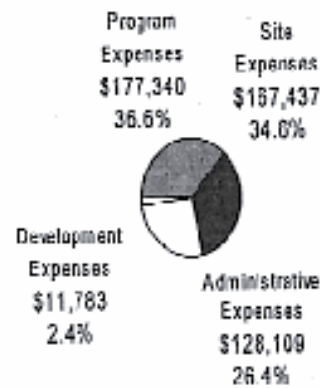
2010 Operating Income

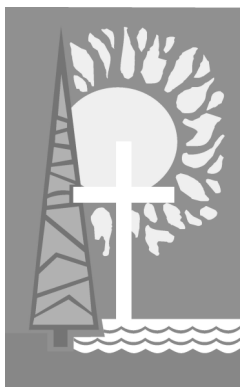
